Thoroughbred is a mythological breathtaking livery, designed for the most legendary motor racing in the world!

Quintessence of the race, she is at the crossroads of the origins of her sponsor and those of the racing team. It embodies both the Greek chariot, whose leather harnesses held by the charioteer stretch with the effort, and the wild ride of the American West.

Inspired by chronophotography, the legs of the horses symbolize the driving force of the car and echo the emblem of its brand: Ferrari.

The Franco-American alliance is affirmed by the choice of colors: French Blue for the background and navy blue & white American stripe. In tribute to those who inspire this commitment, the reins are "held" in the rear by the NART, racing team founded by Luigi Chinetti, pioneer of the Ferrari adventure which is the 70th anniversary of the first victory at Le Mans, and by the founders of the French Ferrari Owners Club, initiators of the last Franco-American victory in 1981 (IMSA category).

The livery was imagined and designed as part of a contest bringing together 21 pairs of students from different sectors of ENSAAMA (School of arts and design – «Olivier de Serres » - Paris 15th). Thoroughbred is the work of Chloélia BRETON (Digital Design section) and Louise DOUBLET (Stained Glass section). The technical realization was finalized by Andy BLACKMORE.
