RHD. Matching numbers. Built in Marcel Pourtout bodyshop and exhibited on the Pourtout stand at the 1948 Paris Motor Show. First example of "transition" models combining the pre-war style and the integral pontoon line. Property of the Marquis de Cuevas in 1952 who owned and managed a famous ballet company. Runs perfectly with only 43,405 kms from new. Eligible for the most prestigious international Concours d'Elegance. US papers. European taxes paid.

**1962 FACEL VEGA Facel II**

HK2 A106

The 7th Facel II built, and one of fewer than 185 Facel II's produced. Delivered new to France and remained most of her life in the country. Original black leather interior, repainted in Metallic Green (originally delivered in Grey Metallic).

**1958 FERRARI 250 GT PF Coupe Series 1**

One of 150 examples of the first series of the 250 GT PF Coupe built. Single family owner from new. Matching numbers, inside-plug V-12 engine. A 250 GT Tour de France in the body of a 250 Coupe PF.

Sold new in February 1965 to Ferrari top customer Dr. Arrigo Recordati via famous Milanese dealership Crepaldi. One of only 34 Left-hand drive Ferrari 275 GTB/6C built. Very special engine. Matching numbers. With the same owner for the last two decades. Fabulous car.

**1966 FERRARI 275 GTB**

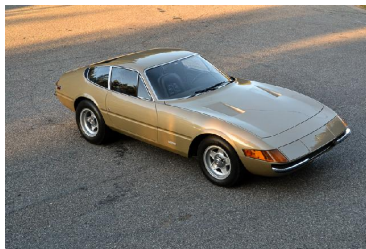

**1967 FERRARI 330 GTC**

The 218th example built out of the 598 Ferrari 330 GTC produced. One of the 54 cars originally delivered in Azzurro. Sold new in Switzerland. LHD. European version. Matching numbers

**1971 FERRARI 365 GTB/4 Daytona**

LHD. Sold new in the USA in 1971. Continuous history. Same owner during 28 years. One of only 16 Daytona Berlinettas originally finished in Oro Chiaro. Black leather interior. Special powerful engine with high compression pistons and slightly radical cams. US title. EU taxes paid.

**1972 FERRARI 365 GTB/4 Daytona Competizione N.A.R.T Spyder**

15965

One-off. 1975 Geneva Motor Show car, Ex N.A.R.T. One of the 24 Ferrari 365 GTB/4 GR4 Daytona originally made. Classiche certified. Restored to perfection to its Le Mans 1978 livery. Race ready.

**1973 FERRARI Dino 246 GTS**

One of only 401 European LHD 246 GTS and one of 114 in Rosso Bordeaux, delivered new via Garage Francorchamps in 1973. Original colours, matching numbers gearbox and body, and well-documented history including renowned collectors; restored at Maranello in 1991. Superb condition today, approximately 109,000 km from new and only 7,000 km since last engine rebuild.

**1977 FERRARI 512 BB**

20903

One of just 929 carbureted Ferrari 512 BBs built. Very early and desirable example. Beautiful color combination of Grigio Alloy over black interior. Owned for more than three decades by French Ferrari collector and historian Jess Pourret. Recent complete service by Philippe Gardette.

**1981 FERRARI 512 BB**

35409

Two owners from new. In the same ownership for 33 years. Only 830 Kms from new. Perfect original condition. Mechanically recommissioned in 2016, including a full engine-out service and replacement of the cambelts and clutch.

**1990 FERRARI 348 TS**

87744

Ferrari 348 TS with less than 5,300 kms from new. Sold new in Switzerland. Matching numbers. Rosso Corsa over Rosso leather interior. Always cherished and wonderfully kept. A fantastic original example.

One of only 12 Ferrari 575 GTCs built by Ferrari. One of the only 3 Ferrari 575 GTCs ever raced in Le Mans 24H. Raced in 2004 FIA GT season. Entered in 2005 Le Mans 24H and Le Mans Series. Fully overhauled in early 2015. Never used since. Single ownership. 605bhp and 1,150kg. FIA Technical Passport. Eligible for the Le Mans Legends races organised by Masters Historic, Peter Auto Endurance Racing legends and Ferrari Competizioni GT races.

**2023 FERRARI 488 GT Modificata**

4872

Very limited production (less than 40 cars) made for private customers. The only one painted in Grigio Ferro. One owner from new. Less than 1200 kms on the odometer. Eligible for Ferrari Competizioni GT events. More than 700 hbp, trully an "unrestricted weapon".

**1969 LAMBORGHINI Espada Serie 1**

Desirable Espada Serie 1. One of the 186 cars made. Totally restored, runs very well. Original service book, Italian title.

LOLA

**1967 LOLA T70 MKIII GT Coupe**

SL73/111

One of the only nine original Lola T70 MKIII Coupe Built. Originally delivered to Y. Rosqvist - Sweden. Original body, original monocoque. Perfect condition. Ready to race.



1967 LOLA T70 MKIII GT Coupe

SL73/117

One of the only 9 original Lola MKIII GT Coupes built by the Lola factory. Totally original: engine, body, gearbox. Fabulous racing history. Rented by George Lucas for one of its movie.



1967 LOLA T70 MKIII GT Coupe

SL73/130

One of the only 9 original MKIII GT Coupes built by the Lola factory. Purchased in 1967 by Taki Racing Team (Japan). The first Lola T70 to win in Japan. Won the All Japan Championship race in 1968. Total restoration completed in 1995 in the USA. Perfect condition. Eligible for CER, vintage races. European taxes paid.

One of only 37 Maserati Mistral Spyder 4.0 Litre produced. One of the very few to be delivered new with a hard-top. Restored by Rosso Corsa and Bachelli e Villa. Perfect condition. Hard top, toolkit and Maserati Classiche documentation.



1970 MASERATI Ghibli Spyder 4.7L

AM115/S/1161

One of the 79 Maserati Ghibli Spyder 4.7L built. Original interior, beautiful Pervinca paint, original engine. Runs very well. One of the most beautiful cabriolet ever made. Spare tire, tool roll. German papers.

AM115/S/1195
